



Designed and built initially for the 2002 Commonwealth Games, the newly developed 48,000 seater stadium is now home to Manchester City Football Club.

With the importance of pre and post match hospitality it was absolutely critical that the atmosphere in the bars and suites was just right. Venues, such as the large Legends Bar in the South stand, have been installed with chain operated roller blinds using a translucent screen fabric. This not only filters the glare but also allows guests to maintain a view to the pitch and the rest of the stadium even when the blinds have been lowered.
