<p>This was a PFI project covering an 8 acre site and providing two new schools for over 1,000 pupils.</p> <p>The building features a two-storey 100m internal 'street', a sports hall and community wing, a learning resource centre containing library and ICT facilities and specialist subject zones for Science, Humanities and English. There is also a medical suite on-site.</p> <p>Window blinds, cubicle tracks and curtains were specified on this project.</p>		<p>Astralux blinds have been used in a significant amount of school projects which is a testament to their durability in high use environments.</p> <p>At this site Pentel proposed Astralux gear operated roller blinds were specified to classroom areas.</p> <p>Astralux framed dim-out blinds were used in areas where a high degree of light exclusion was required. Cubicle tracks and curtains were installed in the medical suite.</p>
